Hold Harmless

Hold Harmless Agreement

This Hold Harmless Agreement is between the following Boarder or Student ("Boarder/Student") _____ and Baskin Farm/Pegasus Equestrian Center ("Boarding Barn/Trainer").

The Boarder/Student agrees to the following:

1. All references to Boarder or Student shall mean the owner or rider of a horse on which lessons are being taken while on the premises of the Boarding Barn.
2. All references to the Boarding Barn shall mean the owners, operators, employees, and agents of Baskin Farm/Pegasus Equestrian Center as well as the owner and family of the property and buildings where Boarding Barn is located.
3. The Boarder/Student has inspected the premises and buildings and found them free of defects, and agrees that, if he/she should discover any defect, which may cause harm or injury to any person or horse, he or she will immediately notify the boarding Barn/Trainer.
4. The Boarder/Student will not cause damage to the stable or premises; however, in the event anything is damaged, he or she will notify th4e Boarding Barn/Trainer immediately.
5. The Boarder/Student will notify Boarding Barn/Trainer personnel immediately in the event of any accident of any kind whatsoever.
6. The Boarder/Student will assume all risks of personal injury or property damage to him/herself (or any other person). The Boarder/Student will hold and save the Boarding Barn and the Trainer harmless for any claims for damages of any kind or nature including expenses of legal defense thereof caused by the Boarder/Student of his/her horses while on the premises of the Boarding Barn.
7. The Boarding Barn shall take precautions to protect the personal property, horse, and safety of the Boarder/Student and guests, but assumes no responsibility for loss of personal property or loss, injury, or death of a horse or any Boarder/Student from any cause including, but not limited to, fire, theft, burglary, vandalism, storm, hail, rain, ice, accident or any other occurrence.
8. The Boarding Barn shall exercise such diligence with respect to the care of the Boarder's horse(s) as is customary among boarding barns in general, but the boarding Barn, its owners, agents, and employees shall not be responsible for any disease, accident, sickness or death of the Boarder's horse(s).
9. The Boarder/Student recognized that horses and horse-related activities are by nature dangerous. The Boarding Barn, its owners, agents, and employees are in the business of boarding, breeding, raising, training, riding and showing horses. Horses can be dangerous. Horses bite, kick, strike out, buck, rear and do many other things that can be dangerous and harmful to themselves and/or to other animals or to humans. In addition, some fences have electrically charged wires. Climbing on, over, through fences and gates can be dangerous. Placing hands, arms or other parts of your body in, through, over, or near any fence or corral may result in injury. Riding of horses may also result in injury. By entering these premises, you are hereby recognizing that you are placing yourself in potential danger. The Boarder/Student hereby waives any right he/she has against Baskin Farm /Pegasus Equestrian Center ("Boarding Barn/Trainer"), its members, employees and /or assets for any damage or injury the Boarder/Student acknowledges that he/she understands that he/she is placing him/herself and/or minor children in a potentially dangerous situation freely and of his/her own volition and accepts the risks of that situation.
